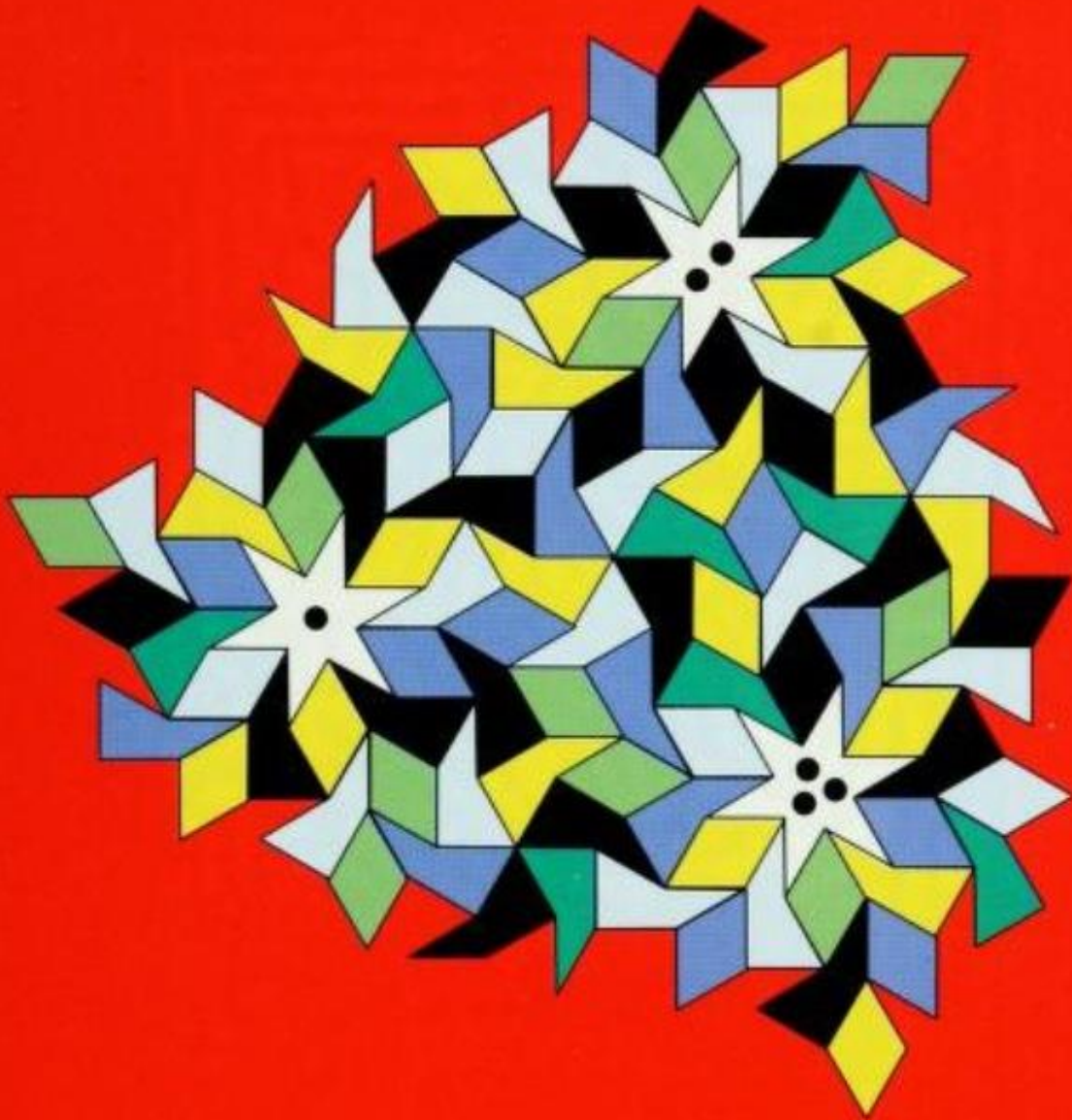

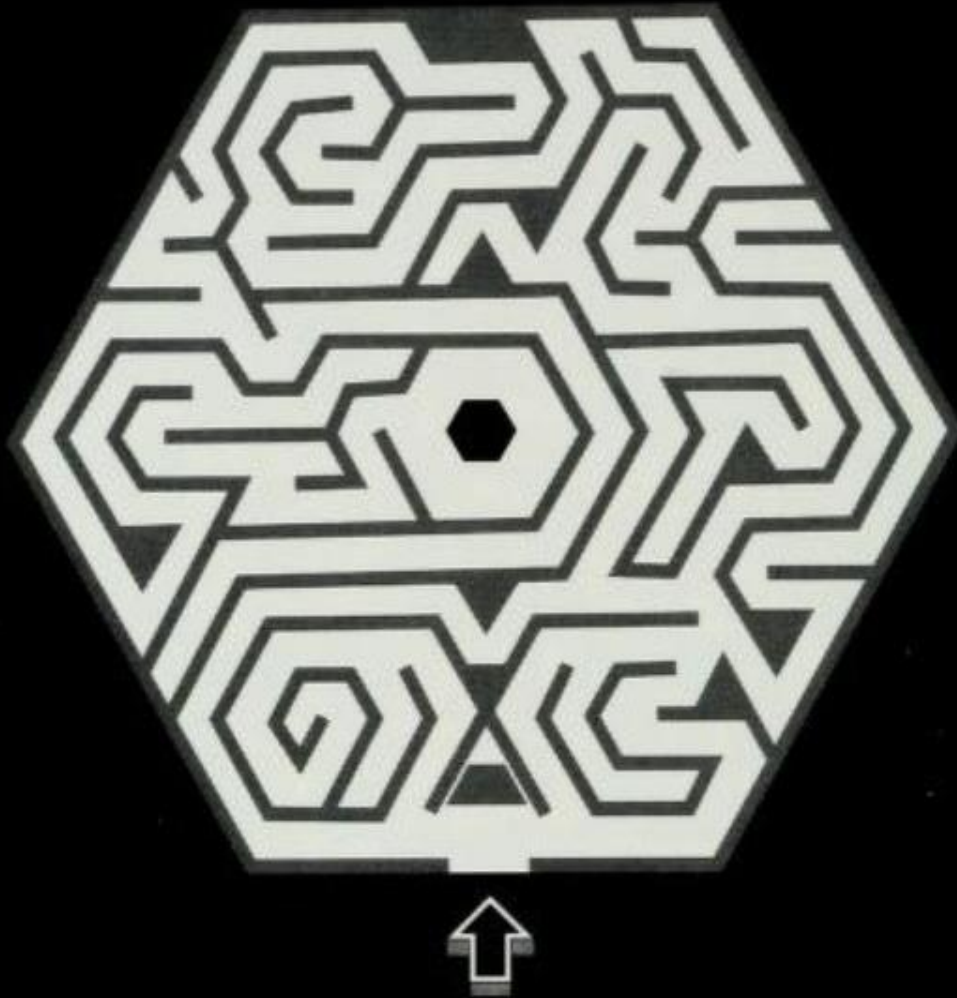


STAR-STRUCK MAZE

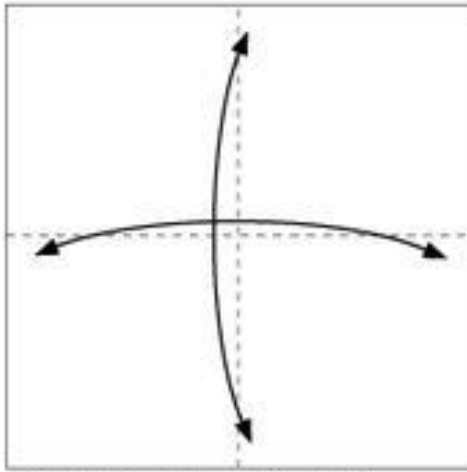


ARLEY HALL MAZE

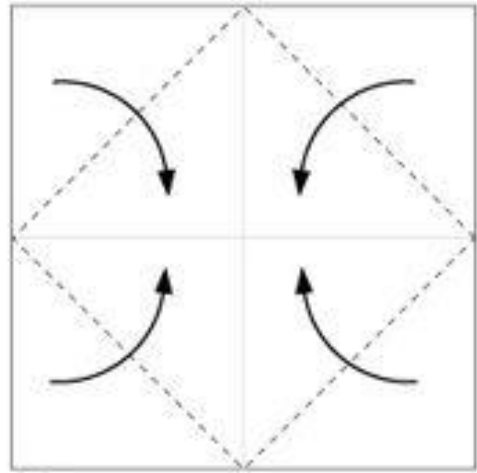

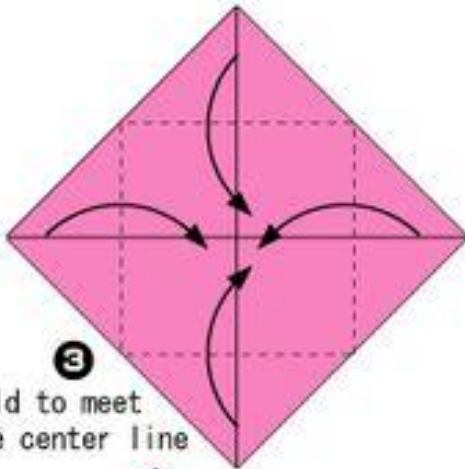
Newspaper Origami Rose



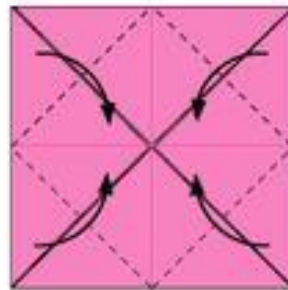
1 Fold in the dotted lines to make creases and fold back



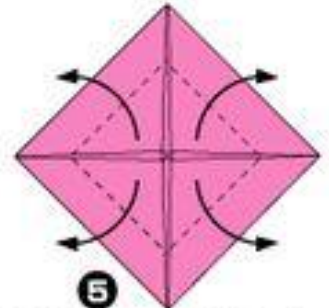

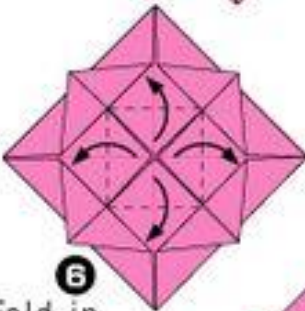

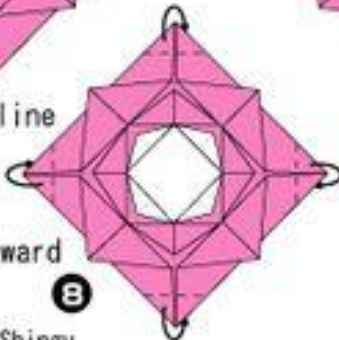

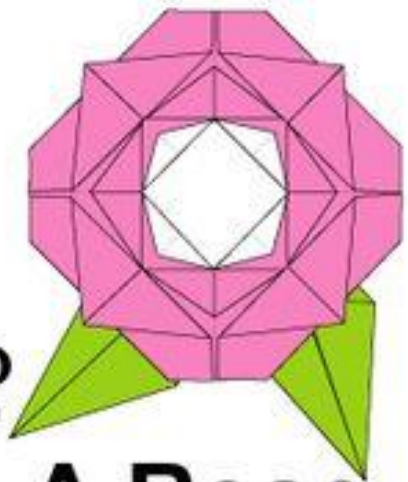
